### WCDJFS PRC Program

**Hours: Monday thru Friday 7:30 to 11:30 and 1:00 to 3:30**

**POSSIBLE PRC SERVICES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:**

#### CAR REPAIR

(A 10% co-payment is required for car repairs unless participating in the OWF program or in receipt of Social Security benefits)



**RENT, RENT DEPOSIT,  
UTILITY SHUT-OFF, UTILITY DEPOSIT**



#### The PRC program is intended to:

- Prevent ongoing assistance
- Promote personal responsibility
- Overcome immediate barriers to achieving and/or maintaining self-sufficiency
- Provide goods/services to clients based on their immediate needs to overcome barriers

Services are provided to an assistance group to **PREVENT** them from becoming reliant on ongoing cash assistance and help them through the present crises.

Services are provided to help members **RETAIN** employment and therefore to continue self-sufficiency.

Services are also provided to meet a **CONTINGENCY** need

#### PRC is not an entitlement!

You must meet certain criteria To apply for PRC :

1. Have a child under 18 years of age living in you assistance group or paying child support. Payments **MUST** be current
2. Must be a Resident of Wayne County
3. Amount issued must not exceed program limits in a 12 month period
4. Liquid assets do not exceed \$500
5. Your gross monthly income is less than or equal to the 200% Federal Poverty Standard for rent and utilities and 200% for car repair based on the household size

#### NO Eligibility exists for:

1. Families without minor children
2. Single individuals unless pregnant
3. Medical services
4. Aliens or non-US citizens
5. Fugitive felons, probation/parole violators
6. Individuals with any outstanding OWF/PRC/MEDICAID/FA/DA OR DAYCARE overpayment balance due to fraud or misrepresentation
7. Individuals ineligible for other programs due to noncompliance with the terms of their assistance: or currently assigned to but not participating with the Work Activities Unit: or those serving an intentional program violation
8. AG's who are pending sanction on the OWF program
9. An unmarried parent under 18 not living in an adult-supervised setting
10. An unmarried parent, non-graduate parent under 18 not attending high school or equivalent
11. A person to have fraudulently misrepresented residence in order to obtain assistance in two or more states is ineligible for 10 years
12. Any AG that includes individuals not cooperating with the Child Support Agency
13. Families who do not use their own resources to help meet their needs
