Question and Answer

Question: What would be a best practice to track the ongoing progress monitoring for SNAP E&T?

Answer: Add ongoing progress monitoring to the monthly attendance report. Wayne County Department of Job and Family Services (WCDJFS) recommends the information recorded in a format that permits copy/paste as the WCDJFS staff will be transposing information to the Ohio Benefits system.

Question: Can a client opt out of ongoing progress monitoring?

Answer: Yes, clients successfully completing work assignments may opt out of the ongoing progress monitoring. WCDJFS will revise the Employability Plan to reflect the change.

Question: Will the proposal require proof for deeming a client physically or mentally unfit for employment procedures?

Answer: Proposal should include how a client may be determined physically or mentally unfit for an assignment. The proposal must describe the process to notify WCDJFS within 10 days of participation failures.
