Non-Emergency Medical Transportation Program

What is N.E.M.T?

The **Non-Emergency Medical Transportation Program**, administered by the Wayne County Department of Job and Family Services, offers transportation assistance to eligible individuals. This program provides gas vouchers redeemable at designated gas stations within Wayne County, facilitating travel to and from Medicaid-approved, non-emergency medical appointments. Participants in managed care plans are not required to exhaust other transportation options before utilizing this service.

How can I participate in the program?

To be considered for participation, applicants must be current Medicaid recipients. Eligibility will be determined following the completion of an application and a face-to-face interview with the Transportation Coordinator.

What information will I need to provide?

As part of the initial application process, please provide a valid driver's license and a copy of your current auto insurance cards or that of the individual who will be operating the vehicle. To maintain eligibility for gas voucher benefits, it is essential to keep this documentation current and on file with our office
