Vehicle repair (co-pay may be necessary)

One-time car insurance support

Rent and rent deposit payments

Utility bill payments to prevent shut-off

Utility deposit assistance

Propane costs

The PRC program is intended to:

- Prevent ongoing assistance
- Support individuals in keeping their jobs and staying independent
- Overcome immediate barriers to achieving and/or maintaining self-sufficiency
- Break the cycle of dependency
- Provide goods/services to clients based on their immediate needs to overcome barriers
- Promote personal responsibility
- Support individuals in keeping their jobs and staying independent
- Provide emergency assistance to protect health and safety

To qualify for PRC, you must meet certain criteria.

- Have a dependent child under 18 or be paying child support. All child support payments must be current.
- Be a Wayne County resident.
- Total assistance within a rolling 12-month period cannot exceed program limits.
- Gross monthly income must be at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines for rent, utilities, and car repair, based on household size.
